No Houses in the Strategic Gap says Richard Dickson



Fareham Borough Council have published their Draft Local Plan which includes proposals for 475 homes adjacent to houses on the western side of Tukes Avenue and Pettycot Crescent.

Bridgemary resident and local campaigner, **Richard Dickson**, who first highlighted this issue to the residents of Bridgemary, is leading the campaign against the development. He is continuing to urge everyone to make their views known. "This crazy idea is a violation of existing planning rules because these houses would be in the Strategic Gap. We have to stop this," said Richard. "I have already written to Fareham Borough Council to tell them this is totally unacceptable."

This is even more astonishing as Fareham Borough Council propose to get access to their new houses through Gosport roads. They are even proposing to demolish houses in Tukes Avenue to get into this enormous new estate!

— The proposed access will put more cars on the A32!
