**“Keeping Grange Clean is important to residents and important to me— I believe in Working Together to Make Grange Better.” said Tony Jessop.**



This will bring the total for the ward to 47 which have all been installed as new or replacing old scruffy bins since I was first elected in 2010.

Keeping Grange clean is important to me and having the bins is essential in maintaining the high standards that residents expect.

Tackling graffiti and fly tipping is another important part in keeping Grange clean and working with resident groups, management companies and housing associations is key in ensuring maintenance and cleaning of their respective areas is carried out.


## 100 YEARS OF VOTES FOR WOMEN!

■ Gosport Conservatives got together to celebrate the centenary of Votes for Women and reflect on the work still to do to in the quest for gender equality.

Tuesday 6th February marked 100 years since the Representation of the People Act 1918 was passed, giving the first voting rights to women and extending the vote to men over 21.

Commenting on this historic milestone Grange Councillor, Maggie Morgan said:

"The progress we have made on these issues has not simply been given to us. It has been fought for every single step of the way. I'm so proud that 40% of Gosport Borough Councillors are women, it's much better than Parliament, with only 32% female MP's."
