■ At a recent Gosport Borough Council Community Board, Councillor Roger Allen addressed the members of the board in support of the Hardway Green Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO) petition.

The Hardway Residents Association Group presented a petition to Gosport Borough Council after their experiences of anti-social behaviour during the warm weather months centred on the Hardway Memorial Green. The residents asked that a PSPO be imposed on the area to give the police and the Council enforcement officers the powers to disperse groups who are causing problems.

The Councillors that make up the board agreed that the process should move forward to the public consultation stage which concluded on Friday 2 March.

100 YEARS OF VOTES FOR WOMEN!

Tuesday 6th February marked 100 years since the Representation of the People Act 1918 was passed, giving the first voting rights to women and extending the vote to men over 21.

"The progress we have made on these issues has not simply been given to us. It has been fought for every single step of the way. I'm so proud that 40% of Gosport Borough Councillors are women, it's much better than Parliament, with only 32% female MP's."
