TOWN TOWER BLOCK WORKS

"I am pleased that Hyde Housing are carrying out safety works on our local tower blocks." said Lesley Meenaghan

■ Gosport Conservatives are pleased to report that work has started on replacing cladding on our tower blocks in Town.

Hyde Housing are removing the cladding on Garland Court, and replacing it with a safer, modern alternative, which will look similar to the existing cladding. Once the work is completed at Garland Court, Hyde Housing will be replacing the cladding on the four tower blocks in the town centre – Harbour Tower, Seaward Tower, Blake Court, and Hammond Court.

Local Campaigner Lesley Meenaghan said "I'm incredibly pleased this reparation work has started on our tower blocks in Town and the surrounding areas, having kept their tenants informed throughout the process, and that Hyde Housing is paying for it to be completed."

She also said "Hyde Housing have assured me through the Leader of the Council, Councillor Mark Hook, that they will keep residents updated through the relevant chairmen of the residents' committees for each tower block."
